COMMENTS / QUERIES	RESPONSE
<u>SECURITY 2000</u>	
1. Security for MBS corridor is a risky job as there are different levels of threats including terrorism. There should be adequate number of vigilant guards.	Every bidder has to bid based on his own understanding of the scope of work mentioned in the RFP. It is up to the bidder to decide what security measures need to be taken including number of guards. To further facilitate the bidders, PMU-MBS/PMA may refine the RFP based on the feed back from the bidders.
2. What will be the fare media	The fare media will be electronic, consisting of RFID Tokens and Smart Cards
3. Is there any surveillance system decided for the MBS corridor.	Yes, the surveillance system will be provided for the entire MBS corridor. The corridor will be monitored through a Control Center
4. Is it possible to place security personnel in the control room?	Yes, the provisions can be made
5. There should be barriers installed at intersections to stop unauthorized entrance of vehicles in the MBS corridor	The provisions are made, will be done if need arises.
6. The penalties for the passengers traveling without ticket should be strict.	The point is noted.

What is the last submission date of the Tender</p>	<p>The RFP contains Technical Evaluation Criteria in which the bidder has to score minimum 70% marks to qualify. Financial bids will be considered only of those bidders which are technically qualified. Keeping this procedure in view, skilled bids are not required.</p> <p>The tenders can be submitted on or before 1500 hours, on 4th September 2012</p>
<p><u>SECURITY SOLUTIONS</u></p> <p>1. There are chances that security personnel responsible for collecting fines may be involved in misuse of money or fraud.</p> <p>2. Does the scope of work include entire corridor?</p> <p>3. It will be difficult for a single company to provide security services for the entire corridor.</p> <p>4. In how much time, the bid security will be returned</p> <p>5. What will be number of hours of daily bus operations?</p>	<p>The security company will be responsible for that. However PMU-MBS/PMA may have a financial oversight mechanism to further address this issue.</p> <p>Yes</p> <p>The bidders can form joint ventures. The joint venture can have up to 4 members.</p> <p>Bid security will be returned to the successful bidder as soon as he furnishes the performance security.</p> <p>There will be 16 hours of daily bus operations; however security services will be on round the</p>

<p><u>GHOSIA GUARDS</u></p> <p>1. Will security be provided in the bus?</p> <p>2. Will there be female guards?</p>	<p>No, it is not needed as approximately after every one Km, there is a bus station.</p> <p>It is up to bidder's discretion and understanding of the scope of work. There is no restriction for gender in RFP.</p>
<p><u>OREL SMS</u></p> <p>1. What is the difference between Tender Security and Bid Security? The amount for the Bid Security is mentioned as one million, while the amount for Tender Security is mentioned as 5 lakh.</p>	<p>There is no difference between Bid Security and Tender Security. The amount of Bid Security is PKR 5 Lac.</p> <p>The amount of Bid Security mentioned as one million, on page 6 of the RFP, is a typographical error. The Addendum-1 has already been issued and can be downloaded from the sites mentioned in RFP</p>
