LTC has, at the moment about 300 operational buses and about 211 buses are expected to be inducted into the system within three months. Furthermore, induction of more new buses is being finalized and it is envisaged that ultimately around 2000 buses will be running in Lahore.

On "Build-Operate-and-Transfer (BOT)" basis Lahore Transport Company (LTC) intends complete installation/ deployment/ maintenance of tracking system in buses.
