## Notice for Pre-Qualification of Contractors

Lahore Transport Company (LTC) has been established by the Government of the Punjab as a wholly owned company under section 42 of the Companies Ordinance 1984. Its mandate is to regulate public transport including provision, up gradation and maintenance of infrastructure (i.e. Bus Passenger Shelters, Bus Parking, Bus Lane Marking, Bus Stop Signage, Depots & Terminals) for the urban transport and related services, in Lahore.

LTC wishes to pre-qualify the contractors for the year 2011 in the following categories:

- Interested contractors are required to furnish the following:
  - NTN Certificate
  - PEC Registration Certificate (For Category-A)
- Applications should reach the Lahore Transport Company, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, IEP Building, Gulberg-III, Lahore, before or on 28<sup>th</sup> May, 2011. However, contractors who have already submitted their applications in response to already published notice for Pre-Qualification need not to re-submit again as they will be included in the process of evaluation.
- Applications received after the due date will not be entertained.
- The Competent Authority may at any time disqualify any contractor on the basis of following reasons, if it:
  - provides any false, misleading information or misrepresents, withholds, conceals, any information in the application;
  - has been blacklisted in the past by any Federal, Provincial or Local Government Department or Authority (including any regulatory authority) or Agency in Pakistan, in whatever capacity including as an individual contractor, partner or a joint venture partner; and
  - is directly or indirectly involved in any litigation against LTC.
- Competent Authority reserves the right to accept or reject any or all applications with or without assigning any reason.
